LAVAZELOPPET REGULATIONS

- 1. U.s. Lavazè Varena organizes the 46th edition of Lavazeloppet, international cross-country ski race of a length of 22km in classic technique.
- 2. The race will be held at the high plateau of Lavazè on Thursday, **23th of January 2025** at 9:30 a.m., mass start. All male and female skiers from 18 years old and members of the National Associations belonging to F.I.S. may enter the race.
- 3. Entries Official Lavazè Websites must he done on the at the link https://www.uslavaze.com/iscrizione-lavazeloppet/. The entry form must be completed in all its part and sent before the 22th of January when the registration will close. The Organizing Commitee could anticipate the closing date when reaching the final number of 400 competitors. The entry-fee is 40€ and it must be paid by credit card.
- 4. Athletes must pick up their race number and gift bag at the Race Office in high plateau Lavazè. Race Office's opening time: Tuesday 21 January from 14:00 to 17:00 Wednesday 22 January from 09:00 to 17:00 Thursday 23 January from 7:30
- 5. The jury meeting is the 22 January at the Race Office.
- 6. The check-in at the gate is obligatory and it is from 9:00 a.m. Competitors who placed in the first 50s in 2024, Athletes representing National Ski Teams and competitors with less than 100 F.I.S. points will start in front.
- 7. The race is in classic technique: the free technique is forbidden and leads to disqualification. This will be strictly supervised all along the course by the officials in charge. During the race there is no right to ask for "free track" for those who want to overtake another competitor. The maximum time to reach the finish is 3 hours and 30 minutes.
- 8. Results will be available on www.uslavaze.com, www.marcialonga.it and on the facebook page: Lavazeloppet.
- 9. Protests must be delivered to the Jury following R.T.F instructions, accompanied by 50,00 €. The fee will be refunded if the protest is accepted.
- 10. There will be prizes for the first 5 men and first 5 women.
- 11. This regulation comply with R.T.F and F.I.S. disposals. Refer to them for any missing instruction.
- 12. The voluntary registration and subsequent participation to the race, indicates the full acceptance of these rules and any eventual change. By registering, the participant exempts the organizers from any liability (civil or penal), for damages to persons and/or property caused or derived by him.
- 13. In the event that the race should be canceled for any reason, the organization undertakes to return the registration fee or keep it good for the following year.
